*Dear Bro/Sis in Christ,*


*I greet you in Jesus most precious name!*

***About the Home Kids:** The kids decorated the Christmas tree on 1<sup>st</sup> Dec'15 itself and had a good time of enjoyment participating in their School and Church and other Christmas programs. Each one got their gifts from different donors and all are happy for everything. They went off for their Christmas holidays very happily as one donor, Pas. Bruce sent Christmas gifts to all the Home Kids parents too this time. They all came back happy and encouraged.*

***Transformational story of our kids:** Janaki was 6 years old girl when she joined us in 2011. We brought her from one of the slums in Hyderabad referred by a pastor who ministers in that area. She was left to the mercy of her maternal aunt after her mother, a HIV+ve was electrocuted and died. Her father who is a drunkard, is a painter who do not live at a place. He wanders and is not bothered about his daughter. Janaki had to live at the mercy of her aunt who gave her food only if she filled a huge drum with water, carrying the water from a long distance, making several trips the whole day to fill the drum. The day we visited her slum, she didn't even have a frock on her body and did not have any food since morning, even at 2pm when we picked her up from her place. The local leaders pleaded with us to take Janaki to some children's home as she was badly ill-*



*treated and beaten up by her aunt daily. And that was the beginning of her story before she joined us. Today she is known as Esther Janaki. She is 11 yrs old and is going to school, having a good accommodation to live in with brothers and sisters and a House Mom to care for her and is in a very comfortable position. She studies well and wants to become a Doctor one day. She enjoys going to the Church and prays wonderfully in the daily devotions.*

*This is one of the many pathetic stories of our Kids who join us. And if we are able to bring this change in her, it is because of the support (prayer/cash/kind) of few people like you. Indirectly, you are a part of this blessing to our Kids and God will certainly bless you for your kind help.*

**Relocation of our Kids Home:** *As mentioned in my last Newsletter that we are asked to find another accommodation by 31<sup>st</sup> Jan'16. We found a temporary accommodation and we thank God for the same.*

**Our Crisis turned into Celebration:** *As I shared about the financial crisis, need to vacate the Orphanage premises, an unsuccessful digging of bore-well in my last Newsletter, I want you to praise God with me for the following points.*

**F**irstly, *God brought 2 new donors to be a support to our ministry. This is an amazing thing and we thank them from the bottom of our hearts.*

**S**econdly, *we found another accommodation, though not very convenient for our Kids Home but can manage for time being, we thank God for this provision.*

**T**hirdly, *after we lost nearly 45 thousands in digging the bore-well last time, God blessed us with a successful bore-well and abundance of water. During this time of drought all over the state, we found plentiful of water in our land and we give all glory, praise and honor to our Lord alone.*

**Developing the land for our projects:** *I request you to pray that God would provide us all the resources to construct our own Orphanage on our land at the earliest. The amount we save on the rent we presently pay can go towards the development of the land or any other sustainable project.
