I must have got up at least 12-15 times throughout the night and that left me semi-conscious by morning with high fever. My BP was 90/60 and suffered severe body pains too. Though sick, I was thanking God for the beautiful system He created in my body to reject anything and everything for a period and clean the entire stomach and gave a break to its untiring functioning for a while now. I was then admitted in the local hospital to get some IV fluids and other injections/meds into my body so that I would be on track again. Praise God I'm back to my normal now.

On another note, I am, very glad to share what the Lord has done in our ministry for the months of April and May'14.

Home Kids News: *April was quiet after our Kids left to their respective villages for their annual vacation from April 23rd to May 25th. So also May as usual was a time for me to sit back and think what best I can do for the Kids for the new academic year. I got all the repair works done at the Kids Home, which is the annual maintenance. The Home looked quite unlike the lively atmosphere which is created by the Kids. Both the Caretakers took their vacation holidays on turns since Esther was with us as she has no one to go to.*

On May 25th all the Kids returned from their respective villages and the Home is back to life. Kids shared their vacation stories with each other. The regular routines started again.

Parent's Meeting: *Like last year, I alongwith the Secretary of NLMT, Mr. Solomon Raju had an interaction with the single parents/guardians of our Kids on 26th May'14. We shared on how best we are taking care of their Kids. They were very happy to know the progress of their Kids in all walks of life. All the parents/guardians had lunch with us and left happily thereafter to their respective places filled with lots of hope and confidence about the good future of their Kids in the coming years.*

Annual Outing: As always, we have taken our Kids for an annual outing on 31st May'14 and this time the destination was Ocean Park. The Kids had a gala time at the Water



games all through the day. Each one also had an experience of Bumping Cars filled with fun and frolic. We thanked God for giving us this opportunity to bring joy and happiness to our Kids even as we watched them enjoy their time laughing and playing all through the day.

New Kids: We are glad to inform that this year we have taken 2 more Kids into our Kids Home. It was my prayer that God would lead the really needy Kids who are deprived of their basic education, food and beautiful childhood and are given to severe poverty. And truly enough Shashank a 9 year old boy and Lazarus, a 4 year old boy joined our Kids Home making the total to 14 Kids. We are so glad to have them with us and all the other Kids welcomed them home. They are now fully adjusted to our environment after the initial home-sickness and are as joyous as the others by now.



Failed eye-operation healed: Mrs. Manitha came home to see us as also visit the Kids Home. At prayer time she shared that she had the Cataract Operation done but it failed and her eye was always swollen, watering with heaviness and pain, and the sight was blurred even after 3 months. She expressed her sadness over this and was worried she had to undergo another Operation. But with faith she asked me to lay my hand upon her eye and pray for her. We as a family united in prayer as I laid my hand upon her eye and

pleaded God for His mercies. Wonder of wonders her swelling in the eyes, watering, pain and heaviness left her instantly. However, she said she still could not see a clear image. I prayed for her again and the Spirit of God inspired me to say that the healing process has already begun and in 3 days time her sight will be restored back to normal. Amazingly, on the 3rd day she called me in excitement to share that indeed her sight is now fully restored and she's able to see everything very clearly with both eyes. All glory to God alone Who has done this miracle.
