***About the Home Kids:** The Kids are all settled in our new shelter. There were many problems concerning the house, but our God enabled us to overcome them in His grace. Our kids wrote their final exams and passed out with flying colors. They are all rejoicing for their success.*

***Transformational story of our kids:** Parameshwari comes from a poor village background where their father passed away while she was an infant. Her mother is a daily wage labourer and got HIV through her bad lifestyle. She has a younger sister, Vennela and it was very difficult for the mother to take care of both the girls. One day she heard of our Children's Home through somebody and got her daughters admitted with us.*

Both Parameshwari and Vennela did not know anything when they joined us. They were 5 and 3 years old when they came to us and completed 5 years now. Though Parameshwari is a little dull in her studies, Vennela stands in the first 3 ranks in her class. Both of them know who Jesus is and accepted Him as their God. They love going to Sunday School and learn the Bible Stories regularly. Both of them want to become teachers when they grow up. At home they would not get proper food to eat and clothes to wear. They did not have good education. But now they have all of these and above all they learn the good values of life and know the way to Salvation.

Dear brothers/sisters it is because of your support (prayer/cash/kind) that we are able to make a difference in the lives of these precious kids. Indirectly, you are a part of this blessing to our Kids and God will certainly bless you for your kind help.

The power of Prayer : *I shared about the financial crisis in my previous newsletters, and how it was met through a wonderful sister in the USA. This was in the month of October'15. And this month again we faced a similar situation. The school our Children go to is given on lease to an International School, which means our Children cannot afford that education. I calculated the costs for all the kids to get admitted into another school in terms of their admission fee and annual fee. It is way beyond our ability to provide education in a Corporate school. So all the Kids and few of us Board members fasted and prayed for God's guidance in this regard. I highlighted the cost difference to the Kids and we were in need of half a lakh rupees for just the admission fees @ Rs.3000/- per child for 16 kids. I looked to the heavens for this support as my hope comes from there only. I was eagerly waiting on the Lord for this support and wonder of wonders, I received a text message from my bank saying somebody donated Rs.49125/- into my account.*

I was lost for words even to praise God. The same sister who supported us in Oct'15 was instrumental in getting us this support too when her brother asked her to send his contribution to some Christian organization. Matthew 6:8 says, "Our God knows our needs even before we ourselves know them." How wonderful and awesome God we have!

Satan's tactics and God's victory over him: *As I have shared about the land we acquired for the different projects, I had a setback at the construction site. The neighbor who is a farmer dug a borewell and his project failed. God gave us plenty of water on our land hardly 10 yards from where this man dug his borewell. Suddenly his attitude towards us changed and the day we were about to construct a facility he came with his family and obstructed our work claiming that our land belongs to him. He has no documents to prove his claim. He was trying to extort money from us and demanded 4 lacs to vacate the place.*

I spoke to the perpetrator about Jesus and the project we have taken up for the cause of Orphan Kids. I shared how my God can take revenge for his deeds and cautioned him to vacate our land immediately. However, I did not go to the Police or sought other help. As anything I do may surely result in a Civil Case. Which means the case will run for several years.

And all the time I have been praying that the Lord would bless this perpetrator so that he would not indulge in wrong practices like what he did to us. Then I learnt from the villagers that this man suddenly fell sick and big sores cropped up all over his body and in his mouth. He had been bed ridden for past 2 months. He is now asking me to start my construction work again without any conditions.

All glory, praise and honor to our God alone for He is a Just God, and honored our faith in Him. Soon we will resume the construction work and continue to glorify the Lord in and through this project. I request you to please pray for the perpetrator and his family that they would open their hearts to the Gospel of Jesus Christ and be saved.
