April'13 Activities: Well, I'm glad once again to share the goodness of God in our ministry through the month of April'13. On 6th April as promised to our kids, the Neolife Mission Board members had an annual outing at Pavani Resorts on the outskirts of Hyderabad. All the Board members gathered together and with the excited kids singing joyfully in the Bus, we travelled

to the Resorts, which is about 40 Kms away from the city and had a day filled with fun for kids. While the kids were cooling in the Swimming pool, we the Board members had a time of praise and worship and then a session on the Awareness of HIV/AIDS conducted by me, followed by another session on the responsibilities of the Board Members towards Neolife Mission Trust conducted by Mr. P. K. D. Lee. Later a sumptuous lunch was served at the Resorts. We could see the kids enjoying every bit especially the Ice Cream given at the Resort and the home baked Cake brought by Mr. Lee. It was also the birthday of Sathvika, an 8 year old girl from our Kids Home, making it memorable for her and all the kids.

End of Academic Year: Soon after the outing, the kids' final exams started on the 9th and went on till the 19th April. After the 10 days of hard work for their exams, all of them relaxed and were excited to get back to their respective villages on the 21st. All except Esther, an 8 year old girl who has no home to go, remained with the Home Mom and the assistant taking care of her. She enjoys this freedom and special attention given to her by 2 caretakers and while she remains at Home, she is taught new things from her lessons and also nurtured in the Word of God. She is given extra help in her mathematics and enjoys drawing and coloring pictures.

Pray for 4 kids: With sorrow in my heart I would like to share that 4 kids from our Home left us. Preetham, a 13 yr old boy, didn't like the disciplined life at our Home and so was always very troublesome and attempted to run away without our knowledge. Thank God that he was traced and handed over to his mother. On the other hand, Sathvika, Shivathmika 9 yrs, 11 yrs old respectively have left us since their mother reached the full blown AIDS status and wanted the kids in front of her before she said goodbye to this world. And so we had to honor the mother's last desire. Eventually as she mentioned, she passed away recently making the girls complete orphans. Yet another girl, Sushmitha, a 10 yr old also left since she hails from the same village as the other 2 girls and wanted to join in a school where these 2 girls join. Please pray that the values we taught and the nurturing we gave from the Word of God would ever remain in them and they be blessed wherever they are.

Pray for 6 new kids: Please pray for 6 new kids to join our Kids Home. Pray that God would give us wisdom to choose the right kid that needs our support at our Kids Home. Many guardians try to join the kids by telling lies that their parents are no more. Later we found out that the parents are alive.

New Policy - consequences: We tried adapting a new policy by supporting kids at their parents place itself, helping them with their food and education expenses so as to bring down our operational costs. But the following observations were made.

1. The target kids are deprived of any of the facilities we would like to give if they stay with their parents/guardians.
2. Since the parent/guardian are illiterates, they are neither able to teach nor help their children in their home works. Thus, the educational support we give is going waste as the kids do not fare well and end up dropping from the school midway.
3. It is also observed that since the parents go out for their daily labor, there is no one to monitor the children and they bunk the school and wander elsewhere.
4. The money meant for food and nourishment of the kid/family is misused by the father/mother/guardian.
5. The children don't get any proper teachings on the values of life and there is no refinement in the behavior as they are not taught these values in their village communities.

Given these 5 major points to understand, the only positive side of supporting a child within their family is that they are not separated from the parents and stay together. But the

negative side effects are many. Therefore, we at Neolife Mission decided to have children come to our place and provide them the best we could offer in terms of holistic care. We also observed that the parents want their children to be sent to Hostels (rather than remain in the villages) where good values are taught to the kids and bring them up in discipline and proper education which can be a great blessing to the family in the coming days. We do not believe in excessive numbers but in providing quality care and support to even a handful of kids and shape their lives in a Godly way.

Our needs: It costs us Rs.3500/- per month to take care of a Child and covers the expenses for food, clothing, shelter, education, groceries, electricity, water, salaries to the staff, milk and snacks, veg and non-veg, stationery etc. We presently have support for only 4 kids. We still need support for 11 kids more as the total number of kids this year will be 15.

By the grace of God, we have all the things needed for the Kids Home. But we constantly live with a threat of being asked to vacate the place as it is a rented portion. Therefore, we look forward for God's providence to buy our own place of atleast 10 acres of land keeping in view of the future projects that we want to do, like Destitute Women's Home, Old Age Home, Vocational Training Center, School, Clinic and a Chapel apart from the Children's Home. It costs us about 35 Lakhs to own a land and we could raise about Rs.5 Lakhs locally until now.

If you are inspired to help us in anyway possible for the above needs, you can do so as the Lord leads you in fulfilling the Vision He gave us.
